

Spring 2023 - Bond Issue Participants - Series A

City of Brewer

\$2,490,000 - To finance various general fund road improvement and infrastructure projects, as well as major equipment and vehicle purchases.

Brunswick and Topsham Water District

\$2,500,000 - To finance the installation of 3,600 ft of 16-inch watermain, including a 900ft directional drill under the Androscoggin River and the installation of a Sensus automated meter reading system.

Town of Chebeague Island

\$725,000 - To finance a broadband project.

Town of Corinna

\$575,000 - To finance a new fire station.

City of Ellsworth

\$3,448,091.86 - To finance multiple capital projects.

Town of Lisbon

\$1,500,000 - To finance upgrades to the water department's meter reading equipment, as well as other capital projects.

Maine School Administrative District No. 37

\$600,000 - To finance renovations to create additional classrooms at the CTE center.

Maine School Administrative District No. 75

\$9,000,000 - To finance the district projects of building envelope and window replacement at the middle school as well as parking lot paving and related site improvements.

Town of Ogunquit

\$360,695 - To finance a police cruiser, truck lift, sidewalk mower/tractor, and paving projects.

Presque Isle Utilities District

\$500,000 - To finance wastewater collection project and Maple and Pine Street Utilities replacement.

City of Sanford

\$250,000 - To finance phase II of the construction to the airport road.

Wells Sanitary District

\$1,000,000 - To finance a force main replacement in Wells Harbor.

City of Westbrook

\$7,345,000 - To finance the remaining funds for the parking garage, multiple upgrades at the schools, and the purchase of a sewer vacuum truck.

York Water District

\$524,000 - To recoup costs associated with two water main replacements projects occurring in April 2023.
